# POWER STEERING FLUSH KIT

## THE PROBLEM

One of the first signs of a problem in a vehicle's power steering system is when a customer complains of sluggish steering shortly after the vehicle is started. This is especially noticeable in cold weather. The vehicle may also steer hard in one or both directions.

Power steering fluid operates under high pressure. Contamination and operating temperatures affect the fluid. Because of these demanding conditions, power steering fluid can break down and lose its protective lubricating properties, resulting in excessive wear which can lead to hard steering. Power steering fluid should be changed periodically to keep the system operating smoothly.

Unfortunately, what most frequently happens is that the fluid is changed only when the power steering unit is replaced. This is a costly and time consuming service. There is also no easy way to get rid of all of the dirty fluid before adding clean fluid to the system.

## THE SOLUTION

A Wynn's Power Steering Flush service flushes out the dirty fluid from the system, and replaces it with clean power steering fluid easily and cost effectively.

A Wynn's Power Steering Flush service will:

- Help stop hard steering on cold starts.
- Remove deposits and impurities from the power steering system.
- Condition and revitalize seals.
- Reduce power steering wear and noise.

The complete service takes less than 20 minutes, depending on vehicle make.

When a Wynn's Power Steering Flush service is performed as a preventive maintenance measure, it helps extend the life of a power steering unit, pump, and seals.

If it is determined that a power steering unit should be replaced, the Wynn's Power Steering Flush service can clean, condition and prepare the system for replacement of the worn components, as recommended by power steering manufacturer's.

**CAUTION:** If the power steering unit is leaking badly, seals may be broken and this procedure is not recommended. Not for use in Honda or Audi units.
